Consider what our teachers could face if Australian Law Reform Commission recommendations become law:

- That what they teach about the Christian faith could be regulated by the government.
- Their faith could not be preferenced by Christian schools when they apply for a job.

- With high-quality facilities that teachers need, provided by generous donors and enabled by tax-deductible giving.
